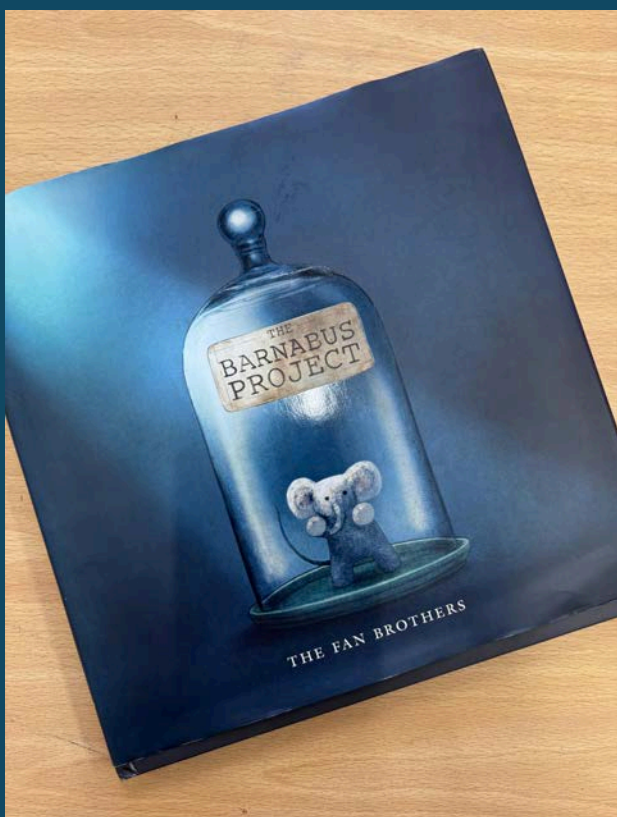
Year 4 have really enjoyed creating posters in Geography explaining different climate zones around the world.

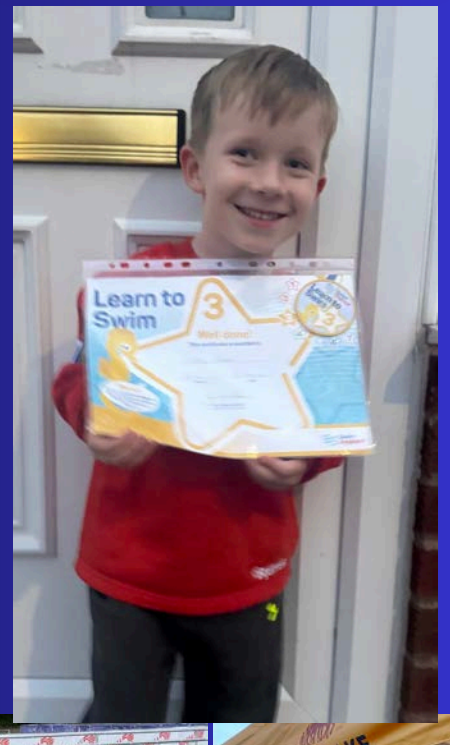
