








Year 4 Our Work This Term - Summer 1 2024

Subject	Areas studied	How to help your child at home
English 	A traditional tale Focussed around the text Paper bag Princess Non-fiction writing- persuasive writing for a job advert.	Reading at home at least 3 times per week. Reading Diaries are checked on a Friday and should be signed weekly by a parent. Encourage children to discuss what they have read. Encourage children to learn their Year3/4 spellings, found in their reading diaries.
Maths 	<u>Number -</u> Place value; Mental + and -; Written + and -; Mental and written X and ÷; fractions; Area and perimeter	Regularly complete Mathletics homework as this will help your child with Maths work they are struggling with. Encourage children to demonstrate their working out and explain their mental methods. Help your child to learn their times tables - play games/ quiz answers learn the times tables songs on the school website. Use TT Rockstars regularly to ensure secure knowledge of times tables.
Science 	Living things and their habitats	Grow plants and vegetables at home from seed. Understand that all living things are classified, e.g. birds/mammals Go for a walk in the countryside and be a nature spotter.
History/ Geography	South America and the Amazon Rain Forest	Share maps with your child including globes. Discuss what animals and countries make up South America. Watch David Attenborough Amazon.
Computing 	Programming a repetition in shapes.	Ensure children understand the need to use the internet safely. Help to understand how to search using safe websites to support homework.
PE	Swimming Fielding and Athletics	Encourage children to be active and work on their balance and direction during play and games.
