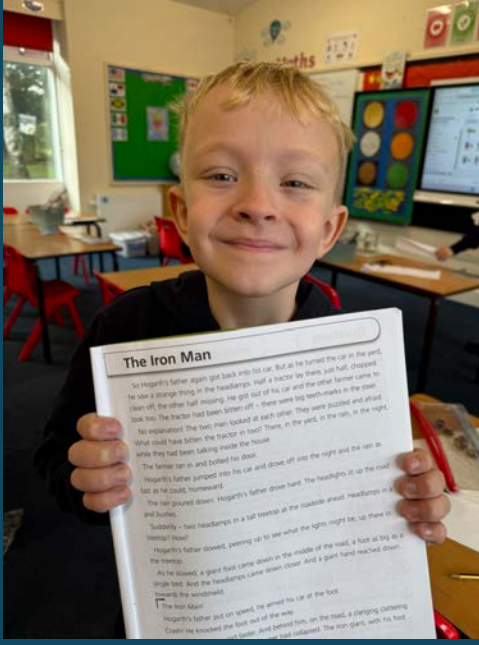

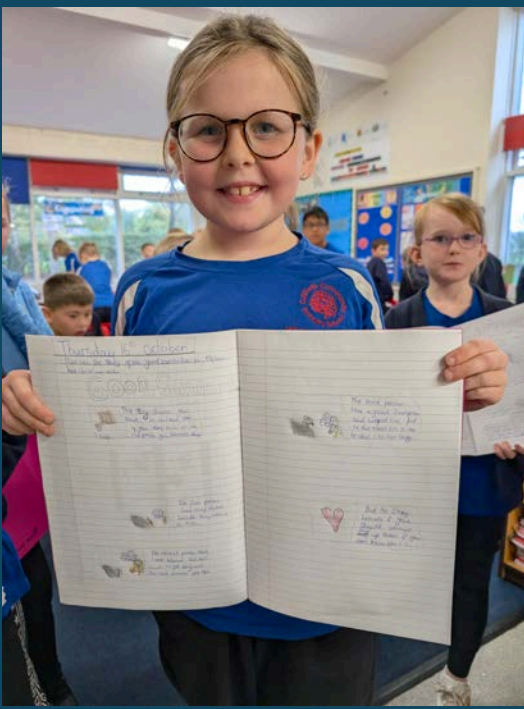

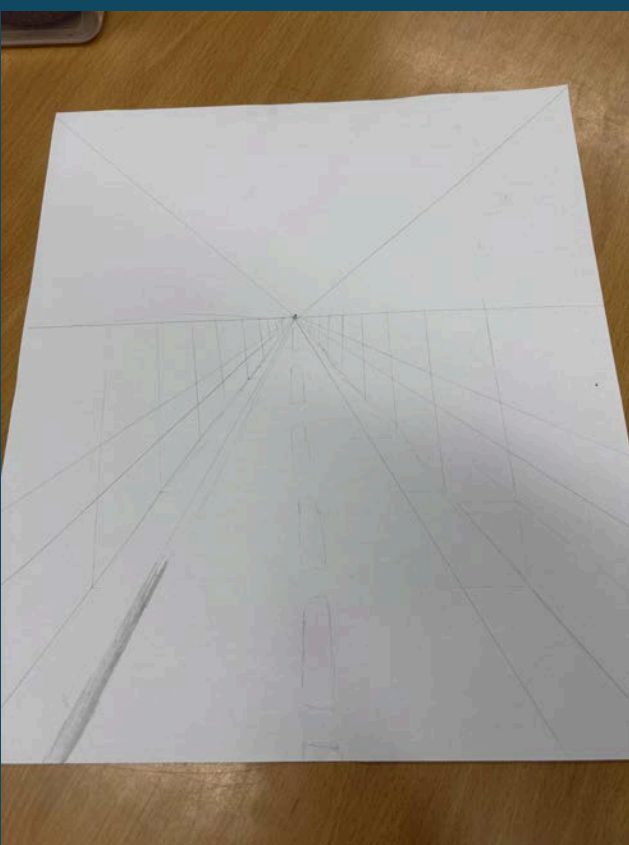
Year 4 have really enjoyed learning about the good Samaritan parable in RE and developing their understanding of compassion
